As a performer, Meghan received numerous high score awards and titles, scholarships to Broadway Dance Center and Steps in NYC. Meghan's choreography has been awarded numerous highest score and best choreography awards. She has served as a professional dance judge in almost every state across the United States and Canada. Meghan can be seen as a competition judge on the popular dance television series "Dance Moms". Meghan also competed in the Miss America Pageant system winning the titles of "Miss Florida State University", "Miss Tallahassee", "Miss Gulf Coast", and "Miss Southwest Florida", and was 2nd Runner-Up at the Miss Florida Pageant, and with that received numerous talent, swimsuit, interview, and educational excellence scholarships. She recently had the honor of judging the 2024 NAIA Collegiate Dance Nationals in Ann Arbor, Michigan. Meghan's students have gone on to receive college dance scholarships, to perform with Division 1 college dance teams, professional NBA teams, cruise ships, on the CMA's, and major Disney movies. With interests rooted in the overlaps between concert and commercial dance, she has presented research at conferences including the National Dance Education Organization, The Dance Studies Association, and the Popular Culture Association. Maddie has been on faculty at Florida State University and the University of South Florida, and has served as a guest artist at Colby College and Utah Tech University. She is currently an Adjunct Professor of dance at the University of Tampa, Eckerd College, and Shenandoah University. He did not take his first Ballet class until college, and by his sophomore year he danced professionally with a modern/contemporary company in NY, and was nominated for the largest art scholarship in the country by Montclair State University. Upon graduating, Cole signed with Bloc Talent Agency and appeared on SNL, The Blacklist, and in 2018 was one of the top 10 dancers that competed on the last live season 15 of Fox's 'So You Think You Can Dance'. Cole has since been living and working in LA as part of SAG AFTRA, appearing on Ellen, Kelly Clarkson, and assisting in choreography and movement direction. Now he choreographs for TV, stage, film, and maintains coaching for Modern/contemporary and Ballroom Latin dance and is a faculty member with IAX Dance Convention.
