DAILY SCHEDULE

9:00-10:30

Individual Work Time with Academic Support

Parents will provide the child with their curriculum of choice with all necessary supplies and materials needed. This is an independent work time where the children complete their tasks and IDC staff will facilitate an appropriate learning environment and provide support when needed. We feel each family has their own approach to homeschool curriculum and we would like them to have the freedom to use the curriculum of their choice. Grow with me at IDC is fully staffed with licensed teachers that can provide support and come up with creative ways to help the children understand their academic lessons.

10:30-11:00

Dance/Music Class (various styles)


The style of dance will vary as we explore all different styles of dance throughout the year. We will not only learn how to dance in various styles but we will also explore basic music theory and the history of dance and music. Dancers will also learn how to read music and explore with different instruments.

11:00-12:00

Group Activity (Thematic Units)

Students will participate in a group activity designed to promote physical fitness, teamwork, and coordination. Groups will be separated by age and levels of academic ability to reach every child in a meaningful way while working together as a group!

12:00-1:00


Lunch and Free Choice

Students will eat lunch together and socialize with one another. They will eat the lunch provided from home. After we have cleaned up from lunch we will use this time to have a mental break and participate in free choice activities with our classmates to promote socialization, creativity and community.

1:00-2:00

Independent Time and Monthly Exploration

This is the second independent work time of the day where the children complete their tasks and IDC staff will facilitate an appropriate learning environment and provide support when needed using curriculum, supplies and materials provided by their parents. Grow with me at IDC will have monthly areas of focus to provide the children an opportunity to gain a better understanding of the world around them as well as learn important life skills. Please see our monthly areas of exploration and our year-long exploration lessons as well.



Parental Involvement

- Grow with me at IDC will be looking for 1-2 parents who would like to be a full-time support for this program. Responsibilities include: assisting all students with academic lessons, group activities, and emotional support when needed. Parents interested should reach out to us to apply. Please note, parent must hold a teaching certificate or expired teaching certificate, pass a background screening, and be available each day for the duration of the school day. The parent(s) hired for this position will receive free tuition for their child to attend the program.

FEE SCHEDULE

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TUITION POLICIES

- Tuition due on the 1st of each month
- \$25 late fee after the 5th. Additional \$50 late fee after the 10th.
- No credits/refunds for missed days
- Make-ups possible if space allows
- Drop-ins must be scheduled 48 hours in advance


Questions and Complaints

Mind, body, and heart take center stage!


- Nutrition, exercise, and sleep lessons

Tuition and Scholarship


Decide if you are interested in the two day, three day, or drop-in option and be sure you have completed your PEP Scholarship process (if you choose to use this as a payment option).
